- Signed 2015 Brewery Agreement, completed & signed "Request for Exemption" from SB County Public Health, and a Certificate of Insurance or signed *Indemnification Certificate*.

Brewery Agreement

- 1) Each Vendor will receive a confirmation letter upon receiving their application and a map and directions will be emailed prior to the event.**
- 2) You can arrive at the park to begin set up as early as 8:30am, but please be sure to be set up and ready to go by 11:30am. Please stay open until last call at 3:45pm.**
- 3) There will be a table on your right hand side when you enter the park. This is where you can check in, get your space assignment, wristband(s), tasting glasses and meal tickets.**
- 4) All brewer reps MUST arrive and be accounted for no later than 12:30pm. We will not be letting any representatives in after this time.**
- 5) Once you drop off your equipment, PLEASE move your vehicle to the parking lot at the top of the road.**
- 6) Vehicles will not be allowed on the field. SBBF will provide assistance with kegs, cases and other equipment necessary to set up your booth.**
- 7) Please bring a banner to put up at your booth. If you do not have one, and need us to provide a sign, we must be advised no later than Wednesday, September 30.**
- 8) SBBF will provide an 8' table for display and area to pour from, sampling glasses, ice, lunch, and logo or name on www.sbbeerfestival.com**
- 9) This is a rain or shine event, please dress accordingly.**

The City of Santa Barbara, the SBBF and Elings Park have strict standards for these events and ask that you adhere to the following rules: These rules will be posted in each brewer tent.

- 1. Do NOT Pour for anyone with a PINK wristband, or NO wristband**
- 2. Do NOT pour into any glass other than the Official SB Beer Festival - Pints for the Park glass.**
- 3. Do NOT pour for anyone who is visibly intoxicated. If you see someone visibly intoxicated, please alert a festival volunteer or security.**
- 4. Please dump over-pours appropriately. Do not dump on field. Ask a volunteer to help.**
- 5. Last call is 3:45pm. Please do not pour after that time, we could be fined!**

The City does not allow you to drink in the brewer tent. If you want a beer, please get a volunteer to pour for you while you take a break outside of the tent and enjoy one of the many different beers. The police are watching this in particular, so PLEASE comply.

What if we can't make it, but we want to donate?

If you live out of the area or just can't make it to the event, don't worry. We can work with your distributor and provide educated volunteers to help pour and let people know about your product.



Request for Exemption from Regulation as a Food Facility

Health and Safety Code Section 113789
